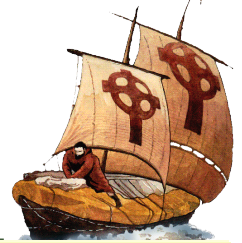

*"Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold unwaveringly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another". Hebrews 10 : 22-25.*

In our series in Hebrews, we are looking at all that our Father God has brought us into including the freedom of a relationship with an awesome holy God that is built on grace and faith, and an amazing assurance that we can draw near to Him! Sometimes we forget or neglect these amazing truths or fall into unbelief or despair which is why we need one another to encourage each other to return to that place of intimacy with Father God, Hebrews 3:13.

The pop-up miracle café and the Mustard seed outreach to the homeless continue to reach out to people outside the church. A prayer group will be meeting after church next week to pray into the refugee crisis and ask God for his guidance on our response as a body. There are many opportunities to engage with other believers in church so if you are new or just feel a bit on the fringe, take a step of faith and get connected! **Finally** it is important to remember as a Church we are in transition, the leadership team is moving towards a new structure where we will have a paid senior leader and a team of elders, and we need wisdom and inspiration as we do this. **Please continue to pray for us and for the church during this transition.**

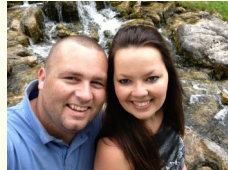
