Hope Springs Forth

'And this hope will not lead to disappointment. For we know how dearly God loves us, because he has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love' (Romans 5:5). This verse has been very much on my heart recently.



I love the reminder that the kind of hope that Jesus brings is different from what we sometimes hope for, Jesus' hope never disappoints, because it is rooted in what he has done for us on the cross and what our future destiny is because of His resurrection. This first Sunday in September we will be continuing our 'I AM' series of statements by Jesus as we reflect on his dramatic declaration **'I am the resurrection and the life'**, and what it means for us and the world, both now and in the future. As we approach the Autumn, we have a great sense of 'hope springing up' and Jesus seeding his hopes, dreams and vision into many hearts in Trinity. King's Quest

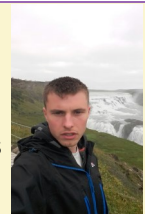
This month we will welcome some children into our Children's Ministry—Kings's Quest and some will graduate and into Access .
