## LOVE ON A WINDING ROAD

**Judges 5 v 6**

When people took to the crooked paths of life in Judges 5, they became independent of each other and **God**, in his **LOVE**, came after them by raising up a prophetess named Deborah.

God as Father never stops sending people after us to remind us of his great LOVE for us. In Psalms 16—we discovered the motif of Gods redemptive plan is delivering us from death, v11 *'you will show me the path of life'*.

We also learned that there are 5 LOVE languages : 1, PRESENCE; 2, GIFTS; 3, WORDS; 4, WORKS and 5, TOUCH. We learned that **God's** primary LOVE language is your presence and **your** primary LOVE language from him is his presence. God so loved us that he sent his son Jesus as a GIFT to fulfill his WORDS of promise and do the WORKS of the Father. Works to deliver us from evil so that we could enter his PRESENCE by a new and living way. We can TOUCH his holiness and be TOUCHED by his LOVE and called his son's name Immanuel [God with us].

God's promise is he will never leave us or let anything separate us from his LOVE. Isaiah 35 says that a highway will be there called the highway of holiness and the KING OF LOVE will lead us home. Sometimes we can say I love you but not know how to demonstrate it but God uses all 5 LOVE languages to demonstrate his LOVE for us.

Be blessed as we learn to LOVE one another as he loves us.

Please pray for:

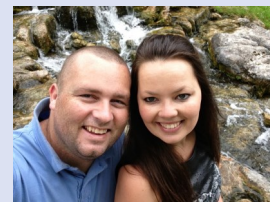
