Mustard Seed 10th Anniversary

Ten years ago our building, The Exchange, was just a building site and the Mustard Seed Team met on Monday nights, in a room lit up by torches, otherwise it was total darkness.

Earlier this year we received a gift of a van which enables us now to go out into the surrounding areas giving out food, clothes and sleeping bags to the homeless community seven nights a week, we did not have light in the back of the van, our light came from torches—otherwise it was total darkness.

Sadly, our homeless friends who we reach out to nightly can experience darkness, despair and brokenness in their lives.

The Good News is we bring a light, which never goes out, through our Soup Run we sow mustard seeds of love, faith and hope—Jesus is this Light, He is the Light of the World.

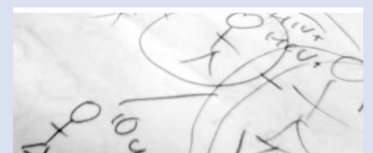


ACET's temporary move into The Exchange
