Welcome ... Lucy Coleman

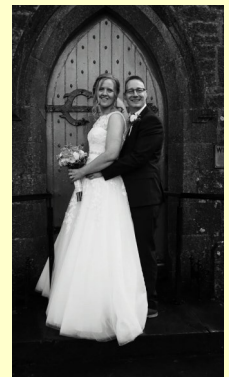

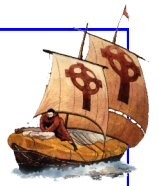

Hearts in Motion—Mission Partner for May

It's a very busy time of the year for our partners in Chennai. The new school year is around the corner and by the 1st of June all preparation must be complete and fees paid in full.

Spreading the gospel in India is under increasing pressure as the new government seeks to protect its more traditional Hindu ways. Our partners are often followed and reported to authorities for their social work and spreading God's love.

Please pray for:

- Our partners, Freddy & Daisy and their team as they prepare all the kids for the new school year.
- For safety for Jonner on his trip to Chennai in June
- Protection for our partners as they spread God's love amongst the poorest of the poor on the streets and in the slums of Chennai India.

Financial Needs:

We have 10 kids in primary school who need INR 1,500 (€15) each for school books, uniforms, copies and books.

We have 3 children attending extra tuition in preparation for college which costs INR 12,000 (€169) each.

We have 6 children attending College with varying annual fees averaging at INR 32,000 (€450) each.
