The Best Opportunity So Far, By Far

With new seasons come new opportunities and challenges, which will be true for many of us as the autumn approaches, whether in school, college, at work or at home.

This autumn there is an opportunity for each of us to consider the challenge of **whole life discipleship** (= becoming who Jesus would be if he were you).

Jesus loves to invite people into deeper experiences of following him. One day a wealthy man who was ‘high up’ in society came to Jesus and asked him how he could get the eternal kind of life that we all long for (Mark 10). Jesus looked at him with love and told him ‘all’ he needed to do was to sell everything and come and follow Him. The rich young ruler went away sad because he thought he would be losing out by following Jesus. Do you sometimes think this way?

As we begin an intentional focus in Trinity on **discipleship**, consider this statement from Mike Breen:

Discipleship to Jesus is the best opportunity you’ll ever get as a human being.

Really? Best. Opportunity. Ever...What do you think? Could it be true? If so then we’ve found it –the secret to life, fulfillment and happiness. But only those who truly believe that following Jesus is *the* best opportunity they’ll ever get are likely to be willing to allow thinking to be disrupted, choices to be affected, resources to be re-directed and their life to be radically altered.

Jesus longs to capture your heart afresh with a Kingdom vision for our lives. He just needs our ‘yes’...

This month we are asking you to focus on our work in the North East Inner City.

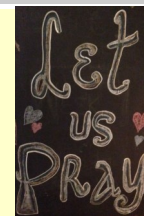
Please pray for all our staff and volunteers and for all who live, work and worship in this area.
