## Fishermen called to be Disciples : Luke 5 : 1-11

## Mission Focus for October — AMAN



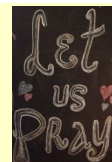
Thank you all for your support for AMAN, especially with our Coffee Bar Collection this Sunday; Please continue to support us by praying;

## October Prayer Event

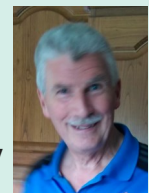
