
## Call To Me

## New Safety Information

**Thank you to Kingsley Prescott**, our Safety Officer, who has prepared a new Safety Information sheet for those visiting on Sunday mornings. This new note will be included in our Visitors Pack now each week.

### To help you have a safe and enjoyable visit, please note:

- A Lift is available for parents with buggies and for anyone with a disability;
- Our Coffee/Tea Bar is free to all first time visitors;
- Children must be supervised at all times, including coffee times;
- Be very careful while holding or carrying hot drinks;
- No running on the premises, especially on the stone stairs;
- Children are not allowed in the Lifts, unless supervised;
- The Lift must not be used in the event of a fire;
- Ensure handbags, purses, wallets and computers are not left unattended;
- Every year we have a **fire drill**. The Assembly point is on Beresford Lane. Sunday School Teachers will bring all children to the Assembly Point;
- All Sunday School Teachers and youth leaders are Garda Vetted;
- A supervised Creche is available on Sunday mornings;
- Exit doors are supervised by our Welcome & Security Team;
- Toilets are on the Ground Floor – male, female and disabled;
- Nappy changing facilities are available – check at reception;
- No smoking on the premises;
